### From San Antonio (90 miles):

Proceed West on I-10 to Kerrville. To avoid going through Kerrville by taking Harper Rd. (exit 505) which is exit past SH 16. Exit 505 veers right, then loops right around and turn right on Harper Rd. Go over I-10, and on for about 2.5 miles. Turn right on SH 27 toward Ingram.

In Ingram, take SH 39 (veers left) to Hunt. Turn right in Hunt on FM 1340 for 11 miles – Mo Ranch is on the right. Follow directions from Ingram above.

### From Austin:

Go west on State Hwy. 290 through Johnson City & in Fredericksburg, take SH 16 south to Kerrville.
