From 1972-74, he led the Air Force Academy ministry in Colorado Springs, Co. After that,



he returned to Australia and led the Navigator ministries in Sydney. From 1976 – 1994, John led a team of 50 to open a ministry among the Hindu mainstream in India. After 18 years there, John and his family moved to Singapore for 2 years and then spent 7 years in Malaysia. During this time, John was responsible for the Frontier ministries (with Navigators) in Asia, focusing on the Muslim, Buddhist, Shinto and Hindu mainstreams of Asia.

In 2003, John and Ruth relocated to Denver. John continues to coach numerous insider movements that are emerging in the non-Christian mainstreams of Asia. He is also focused on the Asian American and Native American ministries in the US.
